

## Sixty Harmonious Years

To mark its Diamond Jubilee, the Wellingborough Orpheus Choir has published a history of the choir entitled 'Sixty Harmonious Years'. The 52-page booklet contains more than 30 photos from 1954 to the present day and is printed in full colour throughout. Put together by the choir's Publicity Officer, Maureen Williams, it covers the history of the choir's activities, short profiles of the five musical directors and four accompanists the choir has had over the 60 years, plus the five chairmen from 1974 onwards. The choir's relationship with the Chorale André Léculeur of Wellingborough's twin town, Niort, is described, as well as the ladies' uniforms through



the years, membership numbers and fees (originally 21/- per year), fundraising and social events, and there is a facsimile of the programme for the very first 'Celebrity Concert' in 1954. An appendix contains details of most of the concerts from 1954 to 2013.
